### **Celebration Choir**

The Celebration Choir provides many opportunities for our members to use their gifts of singing for the Lord. This choir meets for rehearsal every Sunday night at 5 PM in the Choir Suite. The Celebration Choir leads the church in worship each Sunday morning in the 11:00 AM Service with selections ranging from Praise & Worship to Southern Gospel. They also present musicals and cantatas for special occasions throughout the year. This Choir is open to various people of all ages with varying degrees of talent, abilities, and experiences.

### **Worship Choir**

This Contemporary Choir meets the first Wednesday of each month at 6:30 PM in the Sanctuary. The Worship Choir will be on stage in both the 8:30AM & 9:45AM Services to help lead in worship and will provide special music at least once a month.

### **Other Special Choirs – Christmas, Easter, Special Occasions**

#### **Praise Kidz**

Praise Kidz is an interactive time for children through 1<sup>st</sup> – 6<sup>th</sup> Grade to explore different avenues of music. Kids experience rhythm games, playing various instruments, singing, creative worship arts, as well as bible devotions to strengthen their musical abilities. These learning tools help teach our kids to worship God with the musical gifts He has given to each of them. Praise Kidz meets every Sunday evening at 6:00 PM.

#### **Forever Praise**

Forever Praise is a ladies ensemble made up of 8 women with a passion for singing. They meet on Wednesday evenings at 6:30 PM to prepare for Sunday services and special occasion events.

## **Praise Band**

The Praise Band plays for the 8:30 AM & 9:45 AM Service on Sunday mornings. The Praise Band consists of a special blend of 6 to 8 vocalists and a talented group of 6 to 8 musicians that play: piano, keyboard, drums, bass guitar, acoustic guitar, electric guitar, and percussion. Rehearsals are on Sunday mornings at 8 AM and occasional Thursday evenings from 6:30 - 8 PM.

## **Instrumentalist**

Coosada is blessed to have many wonderful and talented musicians. These instrumentalists provide offertory specials as well as accompaniment for choirs and soloists.

## **Student Praise Band**

The Student Praise Band plays for the Refuge youth service on Wednesday nights. The band is made up of 6 to 9 singers and band members. Contact our Student Ministry Office if you are interested in playing or singing in this band.

## **Sound & Audio Visual Team**

The Audiovisual Team is responsible for running the PowerPoint and video presentations during the worship services. They also help with lighting for services and special performances.

The Sound Team is responsible for setting up and taking down the sound equipment and running the sound during the services. They also provide many extra hours of work during special performances throughout the year.

## **Drama Ministry**

The Music Ministry of Coosada presents several musicals and dramas throughout the year. We are always looking for people to use their acting gifts and narration skills for musicals, cantatas and plays. It is our desire to be able to use dramas and sketches to enhance and compliment songs and sermons.

## **Hand Bell Choir**

The Hand Bell Choir is made up of 10 to 15 people who have a unique way of communicating the Gospel. This group meets on Sundays to prepare special pieces for Sundays and holidays.

## **Student & Kids W.A.M. (Worship Arts Ministries)**

Student W.A.M. and Kids W.A.M. are short term opportunities for students and kids to explore different forms of creative worship arts like: singing, percussion, drama, sign language, dancing, art, hospitality, sound/AV technology, and many more. The W.A.M.

sessions are offered several times throughout the year and typically end with a Celebration Service. If you are gifted or have a passion for one of these areas we would love to talk with you about leading one of the groups.

### **Music Lessons**
